Brief Current activities and locations (districts and regions) where the activities are conducted	Currently, Anjita Child Development Foundation implement Early childhood development (ECD) capacity strengthening project in 6 regions namely; Pwani, Kilimanjaro, Arusha, Rukwa, Njombe, Mtwara regions which focused in advocating and provision of Community awareness on ECD.		
	The project is being implemented in the following District councils. i. Pwani region: Kibaha TC, Kibaha DC, Kibiti, Bagamoyo, Mkuranga and Rufiji.		

- ii. Njombe region: Njombe TC, Njombe DC and Makambako.
- iii. Mtwara region: Masasi TC, Masasi DC, Nanyumbu and Mtwara MC
- iv. Arusha region: Arusha DC. Karatu, Arusha City
- v. Kilimanjaro region: Moshi DC, Hai, Siha, Moshi MC and Rombo
- vi. Rukwa region: Sumbawanga MC.

The project objective is to strengthen capacity and understanding to childcare providers, government Officers, stakeholders and parents/ caregivers on Early Childhood Development program/ service in Tanzania.

The current key achievement from the project are;

- i. Capacitated 1500 female and male child care providers, government officers, parents/ care givers on ECD in 21 Districts councils from 6 regions of Pwani, Mtwara, Njombe, Arusha, Kilimanjaro and Rukwa.
- ii. Created awareness to 1500 child care providers, government officers, parents/ care givers on ECD systems and their operations at national and local levels.
- iii. Advocated for ECD through formation of Child Care Networks at District and regional levels.
- iv. Linked 56 trained unqualified care workers with Early Childhood Development colleges/ institution recognized by the government
- v. Increased number of licensed Child Care Providers Centres from 46% to 78% overall level.
- vi. Improved of quality of ECD services to the Centres in infrastructure, play and learning materials, food and care workers competences in the Centres. 0693913952

Out of ECD project we are implement, Anjita established one (I) Child Learning centre in Kibaha District as service deliver to the community. The centre focused in promoting Early Learning and play, Also parents meet together for parenting education sessions. Currently the Child Learning centre have 20 children under five years and 27 parents/ caregivers meet monthly for parenting sessions coordinated by Anjita in collaboration with government.
