CDO was registered with certificate of compliance number 0756 issued on 11th June 2008 with a new registration Number 00NGO/R1/00942 issued on 22 July,2022.</p> <p>b. Since its establishment the Organization has been in the forefront in promoting Early Childhood Development initiatives and access to inclusive education by actively taking part at both local and National level through policy advocacy initiatives, over her membership in National networks such as Tanzania Education Network (TEN/MET) and Tanzania Early Childhood Development Network (TECDEN). The Organization has been very active in supporting economic empowerment initiatives in the local communities to ensure families have some sustainable and affordable mechanisms which will enable them to reduce or minimize the effect of poverty to their families and reduce under 5 years Children’s stunting in the region which is 26.4%. The Organization has also been very active in the areas of HIV/AIDS particularly in supporting the affected and infected ones through various interventions.</p>
